YOU WILL NEED

√ 250g Icing Sugar

200g Condensed Milk

√ 175g Coconut

Red Food Dye

✓ Chocolate Buttons

Silver Cake Decorating balls

Strawberry Laces

Mixing Bowl

3 Different Sized Spoons

METHOD

- 1. Mix the icing sugar and the condensed milk together in a bowl. Mix in the coconut. Divide the mixture in two bowls.
- 2. Add a few drops of red dye to each bowl and mix it in. Then add a few more drops to one of the bowls.



- 3. Dip a clean tablespoon into some water and let it drip. Then, lift out a big spoonful of the mixture. (For baby mice use a teaspoon and for a medium mouse use a dessertspoon)
- 4. Pat the spoonful smooth over the top. Turn the spoon over and put the shape onto parchment paper.
- 5. Pinch a nose at the thinner end of the spoon shape. Then, add sweets for ears and silver balls for eyes.
- 6. Push a strawberry lace under the shape, as the tail. Leave the mouse to harden on a plate. Make more mice.



OR MAKE IT SIMPLE



You could also just make the mixture and place into an 8×8 lined tin and smooth the mixture flat. Then melt some chocolate and spread over the mixture and allow to set, then cut into squares.
